We can confirm that all board and paper qualities from MM BOARD & PAPER mills are in compliance with directive 94/62/EC including the amendments 2004/12/EC, 2005/20/EC and 2018/852/EC and that they fulfil the requirements of the relating harmonized CEN standards and relating CEN reports.

In detail:

EN 13427 (Umbrella) describes how to handle the series of standards

EN 13428 (Prevention) not applicable; relates to the final packaging

EN 13429 (Reuse) is not applicable for our product

EN 13430 (Material recycling) is fulfilled

EN 13431 (Energy recovery) product is suitable for energy recovery

TR 13695-1 (limits of heavy metals [Sum of Pb, Cd, Hg and Cr(VI) < 100 ppm]) is fulfilled

TR 13695-2 (other noxious substances) is fulfilled

Our cartonboard qualities mainly consist of renewable, natural raw materials that are fully biodegradable in nature, such as wood fibres.

The currently well-known compost standards were designed for bioplastics. They are therefore not fully applicable to paper and board, due to the different nature of the materials. Our board qualities will be assessed accordingly once a suitable method is approved.
