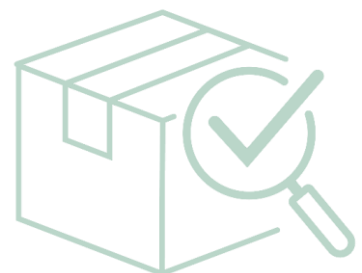

Third party verification according to implemented FSC® Chain of Custody, FSC® Controlled Wood or PEFC Chain of Custody certification as well as MM BOARD & PAPER mills' Due Diligence Systems (DDS) enables that controversial sources are eliminated and that there is negligible risk of illegally harvested wood entering the supply chain.

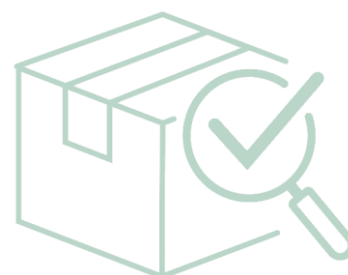
