

BURGO GROUP – PPWR UPDATE

In Preparation for the Entry into Application of the PPWR on 12 August 2026

Burgo Group is completing the preparatory activities necessary to support its customers in the application of Regulation (EU) 2025/40 relating to packaging and packaging waste (PPWR).

As the regulatory framework is still evolving, we would like to provide an overview of the activities currently underway and the information that will be made available to our customers.

What We Expect to Have Available and When

August 2026

Customer Support Information

Burgo Group will make available to its customers technical information relating to the products supplied, which may support the preparation of the technical documentation and the Declaration of Conformity required under the PPWR for those assuming the role of Packaging Manufacturer.

Where applicable, the information provided will include:

- requirements relating to hazardous substances and heavy metals (Article 5);
- PFAS-related information for products intended for food contact applications;
- information supporting recyclability assessments;
- product technical characteristics and data relevant to the preparation of technical documentation.

Product Testing and Assessments

Activities have been initiated to collect and verify information relating to:

- substances of concern;
- heavy metals;
- PFAS, for food contact applications;
- product recyclability;
- other technical characteristics relevant to PPWR compliance.

Packaging Used by Burgo Group

For the packaging used by Burgo Group to market and distribute its products, an assessment of the company's role under the PPWR is underway and, where applicable, the corresponding technical documentation and EU Declaration of Conformity required under Articles 38 and 39 of the Regulation are being prepared.

Looking Ahead to 2030

Preparatory activities are already underway regarding:

- harmonised recyclability criteria;
- recyclability performance grading;
- collection and management of technical evidence required by future secondary legislation;
- continuous updating of product data in line with regulatory developments.

Defining Future Recyclability Requirements

Burgo Group is actively monitoring European initiatives and industry activities aimed at defining:

- recyclability assessment methodologies;
- recyclability performance classes;
- delegated acts and harmonised standards currently under development.

Looking to the Future

Burgo Group remains committed to supporting its customers throughout the transition to the PPWR and will continue to provide updates and technical information as further regulatory clarifications and implementing measures become available.
