Declaration of Compliance: PFAS and EU Packaging Regulation Compliance – Burgo Papers

We hereby declare the following regarding all Burgo papers:

PFAS-Free Statement

Our products do not contain any intentionally added per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS), including but not limited to PFOA, PFOS, GenX, or any fluorinated organic chemical with at least one fully fluorinated carbon atom.

PFAS Monitoring Plan

Although PFAS are not intentionally used in our production processes, we acknowledge the potential for ubiquitous contamination.

Therefore, we have implemented a monitoring plan that includes testing of representative product samples, performed by accredited laboratories.

To date, all tested samples have shown PFAS levels below detection limits or well below applicable regulatory thresholds.

EU Packaging and Packaging Waste Regulation (PPWR) Compliance

We are actively working to ensure full compliance with Regulation (EU) 2025/40 on packaging and packaging waste.

- Our materials are designed to meet recyclability and substance restriction requirements, including PFAS thresholds for food-contact packaging (25 ppb for individual PFAS, 250 ppb total PFAS).
- We expect to achieve full compliance by August 2026, in line with the regulation's applicability date.
- An internal action plan is in place, including supplier audits, design reviews, and documentation updates.

Concentration of heavy metals

In our papers, the total concentration of heavy metals (hexavalent chromium, cadmium, lead, and mercury) complies with the requirements of **Article 11 of Directive 94/62/EC** and its subsequent amendments.

This declaration is based on current knowledge, supplier information, and laboratory testing.
